<u>All Missouri York Rite members MUST register with the Credentials Committee upon</u> <u>Arrival!</u>

CREDENTIAL REGISTRATION: All Chapter, Council and Commandery voting delegates must register with the Credentials Committee (not the Grand Secretary/Recorder's Office) for the Grand Sessions. Organizations, officers, grand officers, past presiding officers and past presiding grand officers have NOT been properly represented, registered or recorded at past grand sessions due to their failure to register with the Credentials Committee. The officers designated by an asterisk (*) not able to attend in person may appoint any "Past Presiding Officer" of their respective Chapter/Council/Commandery as their proxy to represent them in the corresponding grand session meeting. Such proxy shall be in writing on a Credentials Registration Form and signed by the officer making the appointment.

The representation of organizations and attendance of officers cannot be accurately recorded if you fail to properly register. Registration for one organization does NOT automatically register you for any other organization. Plural members may register (using a separate form for each organization) for more than one Chapter/Council/Commandery if they are properly qualified and have made arrangements with those organizations. <u>However, a sitting officer (delegate) may NOT proxy for another sitting officer (delegate)</u>. You should plan for this registration process before you show up in order to know who is registering for which office (if by proxy).

Additional Notice:

In accordance with the **By-Laws of Grand Chapter of Missouri, ARTICLE XII, Chartered Chapters, Section 104D.** If at two consecutive Annual Convocations of the Grand Chapter, held after 1986, any chartered chapter shall not (1) be represented by any one of its High Priest, King or Scribe, or their legally appointed proxies, or (2) have in attendance a companion who is a member of the chapter appointed by action of the chapter to attend and who shall have exhibited satisfactory evidence of such appointment to the Committee on Credentials, or (3) have in attendance a Past High Priest who is a member of the Chapter, as determined by the Records

of the Committee on Credentials, the functions of the chapter are suspended. (Adopted May 8, 1986, Amended May 14, 2009)

In accordance with the **By-Laws of Grand Council of Missouri, ARTICLE VII. Officers, SEC. 82.** The Master. The Master has it in special charge to see that the By-Laws of his Council are duly observed, as well as statutes, rules and regulations of the Grand Council; that accurate records are made, and just accounts rendered; that regular returns are promptly made to the Grand Council, and that the annual dues are promptly paid. It is his duty to preside at all Assemblies of his Council, and he is responsible for the proper conduct of its affairs. It is his duty, either in person or by proxy, to attend all Assemblies of the Grand Council, and to see that the Recorder of his Council promptly discharges his duty in reference to Council returns, and dues. And he shall have authority to remove any officer of his Council, whose actions are such as to disturb the Craft or to interfere with its proper procedures, customs, and requirements.

In accordance with the **Grand Commandery Laws and Regulations, ARTICLE VII, Officers Section 135.** Duties of Commander. A. The Commander is specially charged to see that the By-Laws and Regulations of his commandery are duly observed, as well as the Constitution, Laws, Rituals and Rules of the Grand Encampment, and the Laws and Regulations of the Grand Commandery; that accurate records are kept and just accounts rendered; that regular returns are made to the Grand Commandery, annually, and that the annual dues are promptly paid. It is his duty, together with the Generalissimo and Captain General, to attend all conclaves of the Grand Commandery. A Commandery that is not represented at an Annual Conclave by at least one of the above officers, or his proxy, shall be placed on probation until the next Annual Conclave of the Grand Commandery, if it fails to have representation at the second Annual Conclave, its Charter may be arrested.

ARTICLE IX Revenues of the Grand Chapter

Section 45. *Royal Arch Foundation*. There is hereby created a Foundation to be known as the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of the State of Missouri Foundation as the assignee and successor of the Bublitz Foundation Fund, the income from its investments to be used for religious, educational, and charitable gifts. All funds placed in the above named fund shall be separate and apart from the general fund of the Grand Chapter. The Investment Committee shall be charged with the control and management of the restricted base, as designated by the Finance Committee, in such ways as, in its judgment, is prudent and adheres to sound business principles, while balancing the total return in accordance with the specific Chapter fund needs. All warrants drawn against this account shall be signed by the Grand High Priest and the Grand Treasurer.

Statement of Purpose

It is the responsibility of the Finance Committee to determine exactly how this money will be spent in regard to the foundation's original intent. Any monies considered part of the restricted base or not distributed or apportioned should be placed to maximize their long-term return. The Investment Committee is best suited for making this determination.

ARTICLE IX Revenues of the Grand Chapter

Section 44. Investments. The Grand Treasurer, Grand Secretary, and the Committee on Finance The Investment Committee is authorized, for and in behalf of this Grand Chapter, and in the name of Royal Arch Masons of the State of Missouri, to invest any surplus funds of the Grand Chapter in an amount not less than one-half of all investments in obligations of the United States, or in the securities or accounts fully insured or guaranteed by the United States or an agency of the United States, except for those received by gift or bequest which may be retained in kind. The remainder may be invested in common stock or equal securities in nationally known corporations traded on the New York Stock Exchange and rated "A": or better by Standard and Poore's or Moody's or by some equally well recognized investment rating service. The Grand Treasurer, Grand Secretary, and the Committee on Budget/Finance/Investment are is authorized, for and in behalf of this Grand Chapter, and in the name of the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of the State of Missouri, to invest any surplus funds of the Grand Chapter, in direct U.S. Government obligations, from time to time, as they may deem advisable, and from time to time sell, exchange, transfer, or reinvest such funds in direct U.S. Government obligations. such ways as, in its judgment, is prudent and adheres to sound business principles, while balancing the total return in accordance with the specific Chapter fund needs.

Statement of purpose

The Investment Committee is a specialized committee. There is no merit having a member of this committee based on the Grand Chapter office position they hold. All members of the Investment Committee should possess a knowledge of or acumen in financial matters. It must be assumed that the Grand High Priest will consider these qualifications when choosing these members. By his chair responsibilities, the chairman of the Finance Committee Finance should be knowledgeable in this area as well.

This does not mean the Grand Treasurer, Grand Secretary, or for that matter any other companion can't be a member of this committee. It just means that there is no merit for making a blanket, standing appointment based on a Grand Chapter office held.

In addition, the added language regarding the amount of assets placed in a specific investment is not necessary. The old language chose an arbitrary percentage of the surplus funds and locks the committee into taking a position REGARDLESS OF WHAT PREVAILING MARKET CONDITION AND CLIMATE may call for. A committee that is qualified will make the proper allocations based on what is appropriate at the given time.

Section 47: Duties of Committees

E. *The Committee on Finance and Accounts* shall examine the financial statements of the Grand Treasurer, Grand Secretary, and Examiner's report, and report upon the same. It shall also report upon all matters touching the finances of the Grand Chapter; and no appropriations shall be made without having been considered and reported on by this Committee. It shall be a committee of three consisting of the Grand King, Grand Scribe and Grand Captain of the Host. Each year, the Grand High Priest shall appoint one of the aforementioned three officers as the chairman for the ensuing year. All remaining elected Grand Chapter Line Officers shall be ex- officio members of the Committee. The committee shall be authorized to determine and identify the surplus funds of the Grand Chapter and make them available to the Investment Committee for placement in appropriate investments and securities.

ARTICLE II

The Grand Officers

Section 27. H. H. Appoint and commission representatives of the Grand Commandery near the other Grand Commanderies and receive and accredit representatives from such other Grand Commanderies, who must be permanent members of the Grand Commandery. When the representative of any Grand Commandery near the Grand Commandery of Missouri fails for two successive years to attend the conclave of this Grand Commandery without giving a satisfactory explanation to the Grand Commander, he shall notify the Grand Commander of the jurisdiction concerned.

Statement of Purpose

The Grand Representatives Program has not been active for several years, and the vast majority of the Grand Representatives do not visit their designated jurisdiction nor report to the Grand Commandery. The removal of this section of the Constitution and By-Laws will terminate the Grand Representatives Program.

PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE LAWS AND REGULATIONS OF THE GRAND COMMANDERY OF KNIGHTS TEMPLAR OF THE STATE OF MISSOURI TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE III

Section 34. Committees

D. Investment Committee consisting of five or more members, one of whom shall be the Chairman of the Finance and Accounts Committee, two of whom shall be appointed by the Grand Commander, with the stipulation that the members so appointed shall possess a background in financial matters, and two or more others appointed by the Grand Commander. The duties of this Committee shall be the control and management of the surplus funds and others as made available of this Grand Commandery in such a way as, in its judgment, is prudent and adheres to sound business principles, The Committee shall invest any surplus funds of the Grand Commandery in anamount not less than one-quarter of all investments in obligations of the United States, or in the securities or accounts fully insured or guaranteed by the United States or an agency of the United States, except for those received by gift or bequest which may be retained in kind. The remainder may be invested in mutual funds, common stock or equal securities in nationally knowncorporations traded on the New York Stock Exchange, and rated "A": or better by Standard and Poore's or Moody's or by some equally well recognized investment rating service. Theinvestment servicing company selected by the Committee shall invest the funds in a "fiduciary manner." The Committee is authorized, for and on behalf of this Grand Commandery, and in the name of the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of the State of Missouri, to invest any surplus funds of the Grand Commandery as they may deem advisable, and from time to time sell, exchange, transfer, or reinvest such funds as described in this section. The Committee shall submit a preliminary report to the Grand Commandery to be included in the preliminary proceedings by the deadline set by the Grand Recorder. (Amended 06/01/23) and in keeping with guidelines established in the Missouri Revisor of Statues Section 402.132 and 402.134.

Statement of purpose

The amount of assets placed in a specific investment is not necessary. The old language chose an arbitrary percentage of the surplus funds and locks the committee into taking a position regardless of what prevailing market condition and climate may call for. A committee that is qualified will make the proper allocations based on what is appropriate at the given time. This also allows the Grand Commandery to utilize the Investment Committee for guidance with Education Foundation Commandery Endowment funds.

C. Grand Commandery General Fund Endowment. That an endowment fund be established in the Grand Commandery of Knights Templar of the State of Missouri to make available at any future time a partial source of funds which may be used for general fund purposes. This fund shall be invested as per the direction of the Investment Committee. The right is reserved to amend, modify or repeal any or all parts of this section for any reason. (Adopted 05/19/06, Amended 06/01/23, Repealed 06/07/2024)

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

I propose that Section 41, Paragraph C be repealed. The former Retirement Fund was discontinued by legislative actions taken during the 2006 Grand Conclave of the Grand Commandery of Missouri on May 19, 2006. Since that date, the former Retirement Fund money has become known as the Special General Fund money. During the passing years the Special General Fund money has not always been invested with the earned gains being used for General Fund purposes. Therefore, it is now time to convert all of the Special General Fund money into General Fund money and discontinue the using Special General Fund as a separate fund label.
