

Welcome Ladies!

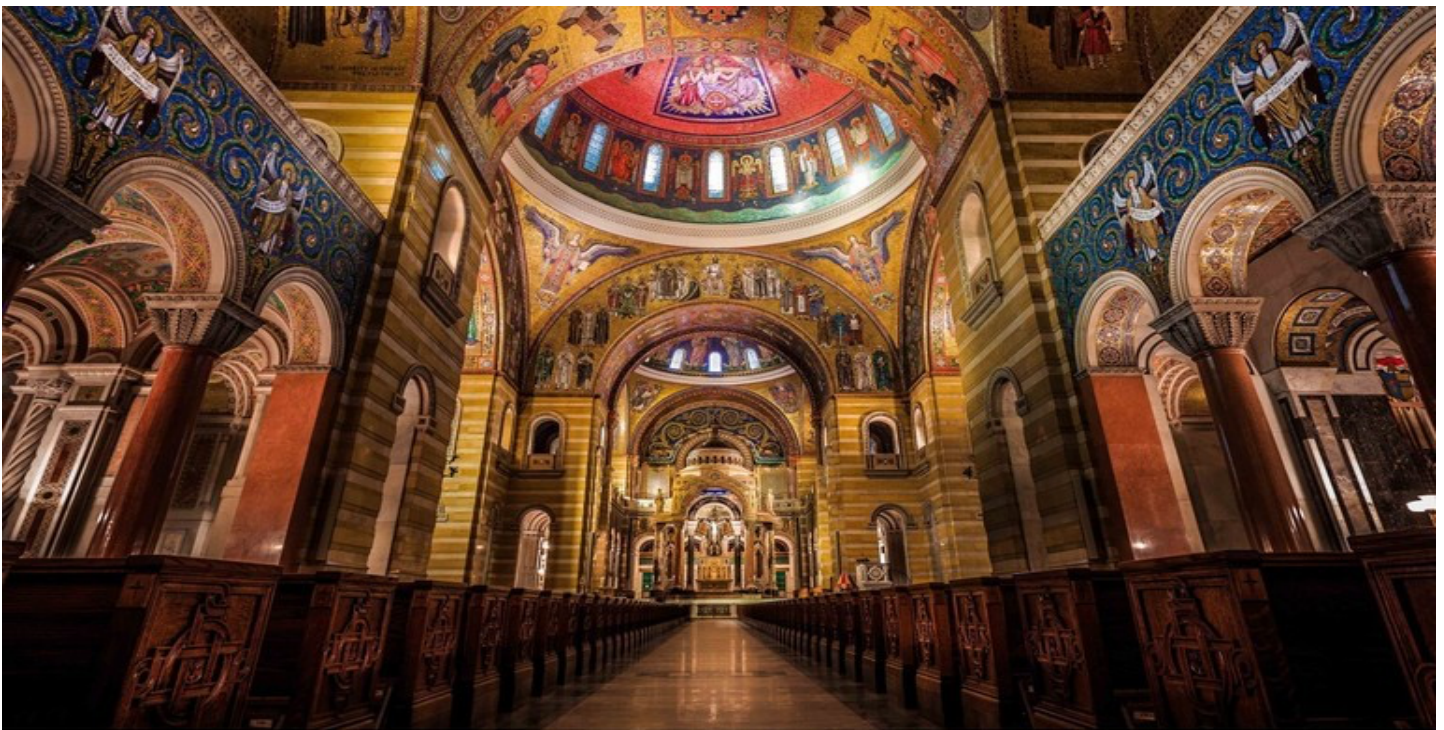
We are excited about the 2026 Missouri Grand York Rite Grand Session!

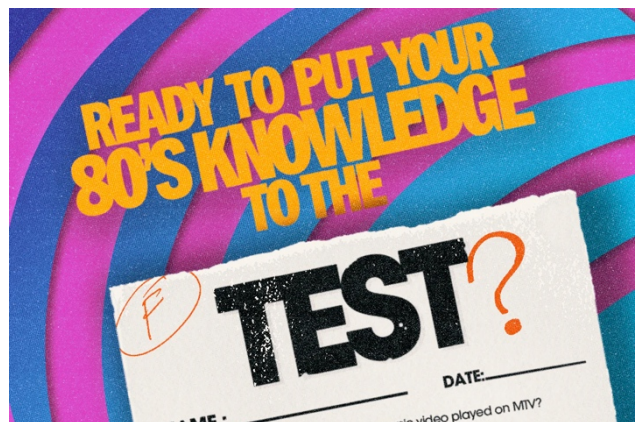
